Clear the path of vegetation or obstacles and mark positions for clamps and tension points. Proper planning reduces errors and ensures safety during installation.

Required Tools and Materials Essential tools and materials include: ADSS cable with appropriate sheath (PE or AT) Suspension clamps and dead-end (tension) clamps Pulley or stringing blocks Cable pulling grips and winches Cable markers and tags Ladders or bucket trucks Torque wrench, OTDR, and power meter for testing Personal protective equipment: helmet, safety harness, gloves, high-visibility vest, and insulated tools
