

# Cable Laying and Cable Tray Size

**Determining the Correct Width** The width of a cable tray is the primary factor that determines its cable capacity. **Standard Width Ranges** Cable trays are manufactured in a variety of standard widths to suit different applications:

- Small control or data lines: 50mm to 150mm
- Medium industrial or commercial runs: 200mm to 450mm
- Large power or solar DC trunk runs: 600mm to 900mm

These widths are nominal inside usable dimensions, with the actual outside width slightly larger due to side rail thickness.

**Practical Considerations**

- Fill Limit:** Only fill trays to 40% of their cross-sectional area for power cables and 50% for control cables to ensure safety and airflow.
- Future Expansion:** Consider potential future cable additions; a slightly wider tray can prevent costly retrofits.
- Tray Type:** Ladder trays are preferred for heavy power cables due to better ventilation, while solid-bottom trays are suitable for smaller or sensitive cables.
- Cable Arrangement:** Larger cables (e.g., 4/0 AWG and above) should occupy their own zone in ladder trays to maintain spacing and heat dissipation.

- Calculate the total diameter of all cables to be installed.
- Apply the NEC fill limits (40% for power, 50% for control).
- Choose a standard tray width that accommodates this total while allowing airflow and future expansion.
