1. Electrical Ratings: Cables must be rated for the voltage and current they will carry. Overloading can cause overheating, insulation damage, or fire hazards. Tray systems often support power, control, instrumentation, and communication cables, each with specific voltage and insulation requirements.
2. Mechanical Properties: Cables should withstand bending, vibration, and mechanical stress during installation and operation. Minimum bend radius must be maintained, especially at tray exits, and cables should be compatible with tray rung spacing or perforated bottoms to prevent damage.
3. Environmental Compatibility: Cables must resist environmental factors such as temperature extremes, moisture, chemicals, and UV exposure. For outdoor or corrosive environments, select cables with appropriate insulation and jacket materials, and pair them with trays made of corrosion-resistant materials like stainless steel or aluminum.
4. Tray Fill and Ventilation: Cable trays have a maximum fill percentage, typically around 40% of usable tray area, to allow heat dissipation and prevent overcrowding. Cable diameter and cross-sectional area determine the required tray width and depth. Ladder trays are preferred for heavy power cables due to better ventilation, while perforated or solid-bottom trays suit lighter or sensitive instrumentation cables.
5. Standards Compliance: Cables must comply with relevant standards: IEC 61537: Ensures tray systems and cables meet mechanical strength, corrosion resistance, electrical continuity, and fire performance requirements. NEC/NEMA: Defines cable types, tray fill, and installation practices in...
