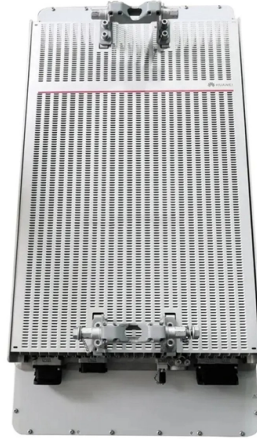


Cable tray clip distance



Overview

Proper cable clip spacing is essential for safety, neatness, and preventing sagging or damage. General spacing guidelines: light cables 12–18 inches, medium cables 8–12 inches. When the cable is installed 'clipped direct to a surface', then the clipping distance should be in line with the IET Selection and Erection Guidance Notes number 1. As a general rule, you should use a maximum trefoil cleat spacing of 900 mm to create and maintain a satisfactory trefoil installation.
