- Suspended Position:** If direct wall mounting is not feasible due to structural constraints, vertical cable routing can be implemented in a suspended position using specialized adapters.

Brackets and Supports: Wall-mounted installations often use brackets, supports, or hangers to secure the tray, ensuring stability and proper alignment.

Structural Considerations

- Rung Spacing:** Typically, rungs are spaced at 300 mm intervals, with C-profile rungs suitable for yoke clamps to secure cables.
- Load Capacity:** The maximum permissible cable dead weight is generally around 20 kg/m, and the tray must be supported to prevent kinking or slippage of cables.

Material and Design: Vertical trays may be made of galvanized or stainless steel, solid metal with ventilation holes, or welded steel wire baskets, depending on the environment and cable type.

Best Practices

- Inspect all materials upon arrival to ensure compliance with approved specifications.
- Maintain proper cable bending radii by adjusting rung spacing if necessary.
- Ensure continuous support for vertical runs exceeding 3.5 meters to prevent cable slippage.
- Follow relevant standards such as DIN 4102 Part 12 for fire protection and NEC Article 392 for safe cable tray use.
