Maintain adequate spacing between vertical trays and ensure the cross-sectional fill does not exceed 50% to allow proper ventilation and heat dissipation.

Alternative Solutions

If converting existing horizontal trays is impractical, consider:

- Installing new vertical cable trays designed for vertical runs.
- Using conduit or cable racks for vertical routing, which may be more cost-effective and safer than modifying horizontal trays.
- Custom fittings such as vertical bends, T-pieces, or crossovers to transition from horizontal to vertical orientation while maintaining cable integrity.
