Distribution and switch boxes must follow standardized color codes and labeling to ensure safety, prevent miswiring, and comply with international and regional electrical standards. International Standards IEC 60446 provides global guidelines for identifying electrical equipment terminals, conductors, and wiring colors. It standardizes color codes, symbols, and labeling methods for terminals, conductors, and cables, ensuring consistency across industrial, commercial, and residential installations. Terminals must be labeled by function, polarity, voltage, or phase, and standardized symbols (e.g., $\perp$ for earth) are used in schematics and documentation to minimize misinterpretation and hazards. ITU-T Recommendation L.1203 focuses on DC power distribution in telecom and ICT systems, specifying color and marking requirements for wires, cables, and distribution boards. It ensures clear differentiation between AC and DC interfaces, supporting safe cohabitation of -48 V , 400 VDC , and AC systems.

Common Wiring Color Codes

AC Systems (IEC/NEC-based):

- Phase (Live/Line): Brown (single-phase 230V), Black or Red (three-phase systems)
- Neutral: Blue or Gray
- Protective Earth (Ground): Green or Green/Yellow striped
- Positive DC: Red or Orange
- Negative DC: Black or Blue

DC Systems (Telecom/ICT):

- Positive conductors are typically red or orange, while negative conductors are black or blue, with clear labeling to prevent confusion with AC circuits.

Labeling and Identification

Terminals and conductors must be labeled with function, voltage, or phase. Conduits and raceways should be color-coded and labeled to match wiring diagrams. If the correct insulation color is unavailable, black insulation can be used with plastic vinyl tape markers to indicate function. Symbols and markings must be consistent with IEC or local standards to ensure clear interpretation across languages.
