Initial Configuration

Factory Reset To start fresh, most switches allow a factory reset:

- Press and hold the Reset button** while powering on the switch or during operation until the system LED flashes, indicating a reset to factory defaults.

Management Access Managed switches can be configured via:

- Web GUI:** Access the switch through a browser using the default IP address.
- CLI via console port:** Connect an RJ45-to-DB9 serial console cable to the console port and configure using terminal software. Typical settings include baud rate 9600, 8 data bits, no parity, 1 stop bit.

Network management software: Some vendors provide centralized tools (e.g., UNMS for Ubiquiti, Desigo CC for Siemens) to monitor, configure, and back up multiple switches.
