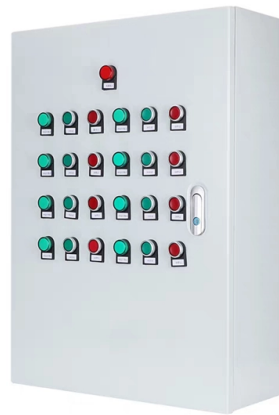


Connecting fiber optic cable to fiber optic transceiver

Step 4: Connect the Fiber to the Transceiver Gently insert the fiber connector into the transceiver port until it clicks or seats firmly. Avoid bending the fiber sharply or bundling it tightly, as this can degrade performance. Ensure the fiber is routed with proper bend radius and strain relief to prevent damage.

Step 5: Verify the Connection After connecting, check the link status indicators on the device or transceiver. A proper connection should show active TX/RX lights. If using a media converter, connect the copper side (RJ45) to yo...
