**Router Connection** Connect an Ethernet cable from the ONT LAN port to the router WAN port. The router then distributes internet to your home network via Wi-Fi or additional Ethernet ports.

- Avoid bending or looping fiber cables; sharp bends can cause signal loss.
- Use APC connectors for GPON networks to minimize reflection loss (-60dB), while UPC connectors are suitable for most LANs (-50dB).
- Place the router centrally in the home for optimal Wi-Fi coverage.
- Ensure the ONT is powered and properly connected; check indicator lights for status.
