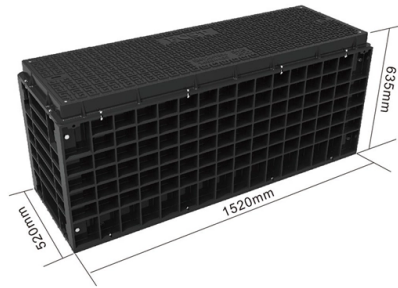


Disconnect the optical module interface cable

To safely disconnect an optical module cable, release the module latch, pull the module straight out without twisting, and immediately cover connectors and ports with dust caps to protect both hardware and eyes.

- 1. Safety Precautions** Never look directly into the fiber-optic cable or transceiver, as laser light can damage your eyes. Avoid pulling on the cable itself; always handle the module body. Use anti-static precautions to prevent electrostatic discharge (ESD) damage.

- 3. Release the Latch** Bail clasp: Pull the clasp down and away from the module until fully extended ($\sim 90^\circ$). Slide tab: Slide the tab fully until it stops, either toward or away from the connector end depending on design. DAC/copper module: Flip the metal pull-tab down to release the module.
- 4. Remove the Module** Grasp the sides of the module and pull it straight out using steady, even force. Do not twist, rock, or force the module; if it feels stuck, ensure the latch is fully released.
- 5. Protect the Connectors and Ports** Immediately place dust caps on both the disconnected cable connector and the now-empty port. If storing the module, place it in an anti-static bag. Inspect the port for debris and clean with compressed air if necessary.
- 6. Additional Tips** For fiber-optic cables, ensure proper termination and connectorization to minimize signal loss. When handling DAC cables, align the module carefully with the I/O port and push straight in until it clicks when reconnecting. Following these steps ensures hardware integrity, reliable network connections, and personal safety when disconnecting optical module cables.
