Fill Limits and Separation Power cables should not exceed 40% of the tray's cross-sectional area to prevent overheating. High-power and low-power (signal or control) cables must be separated to avoid electromagnetic interference (EMI). Industry best practice is 12 inches of vertical separation or separate trays for sensitive signal cables. For variable frequency drive (VFD) output cables, additional separation or shielding is recommended to prevent noise coupling.

Ampacity and Heat Considerations Cables in trays experience reduced ampacity compared to free-air installations due to restricted airflow and mutual heating effects when bundled. Metal trays can also induce eddy currents, slightly increasing conductor resistance. Proper derating calculations, following IEC 60287 or NEC guidelines, are essential to ensure safe current-carrying capacity.
