Routing Overview

H3C core switches function as both high-performance switches and routers, enabling Layer 3 IP routing to direct packets based on destination IP addresses. Upon receiving a packet, the switch consults its routing table (RIB) to determine the optimal path and then forwards the packet using the Forwarding Information Base (FIB) for efficient packet delivery.

Routes can be direct, static, or dynamic, and can target either networks or individual hosts.

Routing Table and FIB

RIB (Routing Information Base): Stores all routing information, including extended attributes, route recursion, and redistribution details. It maintains global routing knowledge and supports route convergence and protocol interactions.

FIB (Forwarding Information Base): Derived from the RIB, the FIB contains the active routes used for packet forwarding, ensuring high-speed Layer 3 switching.

Supported Routing Protocols

H3C core switches support a wide range of routing protocols:

- Static Routing:** Manually configured routes for predictable traffic paths.
- Dynamic Routing:** Protocols such as RIP, OSPF, IS-IS, and BGP for automatic route discovery and network scalability.
- Route Redistribution:** Enables sharing of routes between different protocols, including extended attributes like OSPF area IDs and router IDs.
- Exterior Gateway Protocols (EGPs):** BGP is supported for inter-autonomous system routing.

- NSR/GR (Non-Stop Routing/Graceful Restart):** Maintains FIB entries during protocol switchover to prevent packet loss.
