Temporary wiring should comply with NEC Article 590, and flexible cords must be suitable for hard or extra-hard usage depending on site conditions (NEC, OSHA).

Environmental Protection: For damp or wet locations, ensure that GFCIs are installed on all receptacles. Temporary power systems must be protected from weather, foot traffic, and mechanical damage (OSHA, NEC).

Documentation and Traceability: Maintain records of installation dates, equipment types, inspection results, and corrective actions. This ensures accountability and facilitates future inspections or maintenance (SafetyCulture checklist).

Practical Inspection Steps

Check physical condition of the box, including enclosure integrity, labels, and covers.

Test grounding continuity from the main supply to all outlets.
