- Cable Protection:** The box protects fibers from physical damage, such as bending, crushing, or pulling, and maintains proper bend radius to prevent signal attenuation.
- Slack Storage:** Excess fiber can be neatly stored in trays for future re-termination or maintenance.
- Accessibility and Maintenance:** Front-access panels and modular components allow technicians to perform testing, troubleshooting, and move/add/change (MAC) operations efficiently.
