- Indication Lights:** Visual indicators showing the status of mains power or specific circuits, often included in modern or smart DB boxes.
- Smart Modules (Optional):** Advanced distribution boxes may include energy monitoring units, communication modules, or automation interfaces for remote control and energy management.

Materials and Construction

Distribution boxes are typically made from engineering thermoplastics like polycarbonate or ASA, or epoxy-coated/powder-coated stainless steel, providing durability, insulation, and fire resistance.

- Single-phase and three-phase DB boxes:** For residential or industrial applications, respectively.
- Surface-mounted, flush-mounted, or pole-mounted:** Depending on installation requirements.
- Lighting, power, and control distribution boxes:** Designed for specific circuit types or integration with control systems.
