3D Modeling: Modern CAD tools, such as AutoCAD MEP or MagiCAD, allow 3D representation of cable trays, including elevation, alignment, offsets, bends, and branches. 3D modeling improves coordination with other disciplines, helps detect clashes, and allows automatic adjustment of routing and fittings.

CAD Modeling Techniques

Pre-definition of Routing Preferences: Define alignment, elevation, offsets, bend types, and branch types before modeling.

Segment Drawing: Draw individual segments by specifying start and end points, then connect them to form runs.

Automatic Fittings: CAD software can automatically insert fittings to connect segments, risers, and branches, ensuring continuity and proper geometry.

Property Inheritance: When connecting new segments to existing runs, properties such as system type and part type are inherited for consistency.

Editing and Adjustment: Modify existing containment, resolve routing conflicts, adjust elevations, or copy/move branches to optimize the layout.
