Termination boxes are primarily used for individual homes, offices, or small indoor distribution points, serving a limited number of users and ensuring reliable, protected connections to ONUs or ONTs. Fiber Distribution Box / Splitter Box A fiber distribution box or splitter distribution box is an intermediate node in FTTH networks, designed to distribute optical signals from feeder cables to multiple drop cables. Key features include: Integration of fiber termination, splicing, and PLC optical splitters (tube or cassette type). Capacity options: 4, 8, 16, 32, 64 cores, suitable for multiple subscribers. Indoor/outdoor installation with dustproof and waterproof protection. Flexible cable management and easy maintenance access. These boxes are typically installed in corridors, small community telecom rooms, outdoor poles, or wall-mounted locations, and they act as the distribution layer between the ODF in the central office and the fiber terminal box at the user site. Its primary functions include: Termination, splicing, and patching of backbone fiber cables. Centralized management of fiber routes with clearly labeled ports. Support for network reconfig...
