- Fiber Type Compatibility:** Match single-mode to single-mode or multimode to multimode to avoid performance issues.
- Environmental Protection:** Some adapters come with protective shrouds for dust and environmental resistance.
- Port Density:** SC connectors are larger than ST, so consider space constraints in your switch or patch panel.
