Stainless steel (AISI 316L) is preferred for high-corrosion environments, while pre-galvanized or hot-dip galvanized steel is common for indoor or moderate conditions. Installation Considerations Ensure proper alignment of risers and elbows to prevent cable stress. Use adequate support...
