They are ideal for remote or outdoor industrial applications and can support high-power devices with PoE++ standards, while maintaining rugged construction for harsh environments.
- 4. Layer 2 Industrial Switches**
Operating at the data link layer, Layer 2 switches forward frames based on MAC addresses. They are efficient for local traffic and basic network segmentation through VLANs. These switches are suitable for smaller industrial networks where routing between subnets is not required.
- 5. Layer 3 Industrial Switches**
Layer 3 switches provide routing capabilities between subnets, supporting static routes, RIP, and VRRP. They reduce broadcast traffic, enable inter-VLAN routing, and improve fault isolation and network security. These switches are used in larger industrial networks requiring traffic segregation and low latency.
