

H3C switch fiber optic cable not working

Replace the module with a known working H3C transceiver to rule out module failure.

Step 3: Use CLI Diagnostics Execute `display interface brief` to check the port status and see if it is administratively up or down. Use `display transceiver interface` or `display transceiver alarm interface` to monitor optical power levels and alarms. Look for error packets, CRC errors, or link flaps that indicate physical or configuration issues.

Step 4: Test the Fiber Cable Swap the fiber cable with a known good cable to rule out damage. Use an optical power meter to measure signal strength at both TX and RX ends. Weak or absent signals indicate cable or connector problems.

Step 5: Check Configuration Ensure the port is enabled and not administratively shut down. Verify speed and duplex settings match the connected device. Remove any ACLs or QoS policies that may block traffic if errors persist.

Step 6: Escalate if Needed If the above steps do not resolve the issue, replace the local or peer port to verify hardware functionality. Contact H3C Support for persistent problems, especially if the switch logs indicate transceiver or port faults.
