Preparation and Safety Turn off the main power supply before starting. Choose a suitable location: dry, ventilated, and accessible, typically around 1.5 meters above the floor. Ensure the box is level and stable; use waterproof enclosures for outdoor installations.

Mounting the Box Mark and drill holes on the wall or mounting surface. Fix the box using expansion bolts or screws, ensuring it is secure and level.

Wire Preparation Strip insulation from wires to the correct length. Use the appropriate wire gauge for the load and ensure proper insulation.

Connecting Input Power Connect the phase (live) wire to the input terminal of the main MCB. Connect the neutral wire to the neutral link. Connect the ground wire to the earth terminal or busbar.

Connecting Protective Devices The output of the main MCB connects to the input of the RCCB (if used). Connect the output of the RCCB to the branch MCBs. For double-pole MCBs, connect both phase and neutral; for single-pole MCBs, connect only the phase wire.

Branch Circuit Wiring Connect each branch circuit to its respective MCB. Ensure neat cable management and secure connections to prevent loose contacts.
