

Horizontal Installation Method of Cable Trays

Supports should be spaced according to tray type and load, typically 1.5 to 3 meters apart. Ensure hangers are level and securely anchored to the building structure using appropriate fasteners for steel or concrete.

Step 4: Mount the Tray Lift the tray sections onto the supports. For ladder trays, position clamps around the siderails and secure with washers and hex nuts on threaded rods. Adjust the tray horizontally by fine-tuning the nuts until the tray is level. Ensure vertical distance between multiple layers of trays is maintained (e.g., at least 30 cm between basket and solid-bottom trays) to avoid interference.

Step 5: Connect and Align Sections Use splice plates or connectors to join tray sections. Align trays straight and level before tightening to prevent sagging or misalignment. Double-check that all clamps and fasteners are secure.

Step 6: Final Checks Verify that the tray is level, properly supported, and capable of handling the intended cable load. Ensure compliance with maximum loa...
