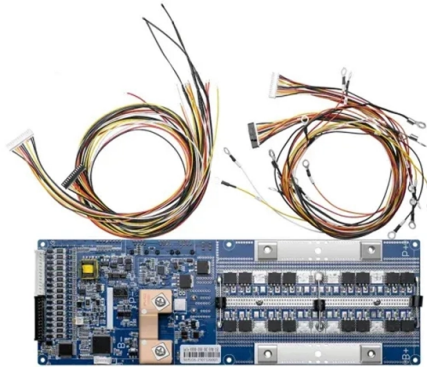


How do I know if the pigtail has a mesh
