Connecting Wires Strip 5/8 to 3/4 inch of insulation from each wire end, following wire nut specifications. Identify wires by color: hot (black/red), neutral (white/gray), and ground (bare or green). Connect ground wires first, twisting them together and securing with a wire nut. Connect hot wires and neutral wires separately, ensuring tight, secure splices. Arrange wires neatly inside the box to avoid overcrowding and maintain accessibility.

Grounding and Safety If using a metal box, attach a ground wire to the grounding screw. Proper grounding is essential for safety and code compliance. After all connections are made, install the cover to protect the splices and maintain accessibility for future inspection or repairs.
