

How to assign PoE to a switch



AI Overview

To assign PoE to a switch, you need to ensure the switch supports PoE, plan the power budget, and enable PoE on the desired ports either automatically or manually.

Step 1: Verify PoE Capability Ensure your switch supports PoE and check the standard it uses (IEEE 802.3af, 802.3at, or 802.3bt). This determines the maximum power per port and compatibility with your devices such as IP cameras, VoIP phones, or wireless access points.

Step 2: Plan Power Budget Calculate the total power required by all connected devices. Add a safety margin (typically 25–30%) to account for cable loss and future expansion. For example, six 8W cameras and two 20W PTZ cameras require 88W; choose a switch with at least 120W PoE capacity.

Step 3: Connect Devices Use Cat5e or Cat6 Ethernet cables to connect PoE-enabled devices to the switch ports. Ensure the devices are compatible with the switch's PoE standard.

Step 4: Enable PoE on Ports Most modern switches have PoE enabled by default in auto mode. For manual configuration, access the switch via CLI or web interface:

Cisco CLI Example:

```
Switch> enable
Switch# configure terminal
Switch(config)# interface gi1
Switch(config-if)# power inline auto auto
```

enables automatic detection and power allocation. never disables PoE on the port. You can also apply time-range settings if needed:

```
Switch(config-if)# power inline auto time-range workhour
```

Verify configuration with:

```
Switch# show power inline interface gi1
```

This displays port state, power consumption, and connected device information.

Step 5: Monitor and Manage PoE Regularly check PoE status to prevent oversubscription. Use commands like `show power inline` to monitor power usage. For non-CDP/LLDP devices, you may need to manually configure power using `power inline static` or `power inline consumption` commands. Consider VLAN segmentation, remote management, and security settings to optimize PoE delivery.
