- Routing in the terminal box:** Arrange the fibers along the trays, avoiding sharp bends, and secure them with cable ties or protective sleeves.

Mechanical splicing is quick, flexible, and does not require power, making it ideal for field installations or locations without immediate electrical access.

- Identify the transceiver:** The optical transceiver inside the terminal box converts optical signals to electrical signals. It typically requires a DC power supply (commonly 5V, 12V, or 24V depending on the device).
