Neutral and Ground Separation: In a subpanel, the neutral bus and ground bus must remain separate to prevent fault currents from traveling through the neutral conductor. Only the main panel bonds neutral and ground.

Load Balancing: For three-phase systems, distribute loads evenly across phases to minimize voltage imbalance and overheating. For single-phase systems, balance lighting, outlets, and appliance circuits across the available breakers.

Wire Sizing and Color Coding: Select wire sizes according to the circuit load (e.g., 2.5mm...
