

How to connect a gigabit optical module

Step 4: Connect the Optical Fiber For optical SFP modules, use a compatible fiber patch cord (single-mode or multi-mode) and connect it to the module. Ensure proper orientation of the fiber connectors (LC, SC, etc.) and avoid bending the fiber sharply to prevent signal loss ().

Step 5: Verify the Connection Power on the switch if it was turned off. Check the SFP module's LED indicators; a green light usually indicates a successful link (). Confirm network connectivity by testing data transmission between devices.

Additional Tips Use SFP modules from the switch manufacturer when possible to ensure compatibility and reliability (). Copper SFP modules can convert SFP ports to RJ45, supporting full-duplex gigabit transmission over short distances (up to 100 meters with Cat6) (). Av...
