

How to connect the fiber optic splice box interface

Observe minimum bending radius limits to prevent signal loss. Attach intermediate fixings to prevent fiber slippage. Stack multiple trays if the splice box requires higher capacity, ensuring accessibility for future maintenance ().

Step 4: Splice the Fibers Choose between fusion splicing (melting fiber ends together for minimal loss) or mechanical splicing (aligning fibers with a precision sleeve). For fusion splicing, strip the fiber coating, clean the fiber, cleave it at a 90° angle, and insert it into the splicer. The splicer will automatically align and weld the fibers. For mechanical splicing, align the fibers in a connector sleeve with index gel to hold them in place ().

Step 5: Protect and Secure the Splice After splicing, place the fibers into protective splice sleeves and insert them into the splice tray slots. Ensure excess fiber is coiled neatly within the...
