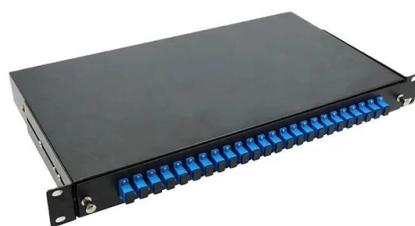


How to connect the pigtail fiber to the BBU
