

How to install a router for fiber optic internet access

Step 4: Configure Your Network

Access your router's admin interface to set up Wi-Fi SSID and password. Enable security protocols such as WPA3 for home networks or enterprise-grade security for business setups. Update the firmware on both the router and ONT to ensure optimal performance.

Step 5: Optimize Your Fiber Connection

Use wired Ethernet connections for critical applications like gaming or video conferencing. Test your internet speed and adjust router settings if necessary. Position the router centrally in your home for the best Wi-Fi coverage. Consider upgrading to Wi-Fi 6 or...

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
