Pulling Tension: Do not exceed the maximum tensile force specified for the cable, often around 600 lbf for OSP loose tube or ribbon cables. Cable Crush and Pinching: Avoid crushing or pinching the cable in ducts, manholes, or handholes. Use of Swivels and Grips: Swivels prevent cable twist, and proper grips ensure the jacket and core are not damaged during pulling.
