

How to make underground cable trays

Ladder trays allow airflow and easy cable entry, while perforated trays are suitable for lighter loads. **Supports:** Secure trays with brackets or clamps, spaced 1.5 to 3 meters apart, depending on tray type and load. **Alignment:** Ensure trays are straight, level, and properly connected using fittings and connectors.

Cable Laying and Protection Lay cables carefully on the sand bed inside the tray, avoiding sharp bends or overlapping that could damage insulation. Cover cables with another layer of sand, then a protective layer of bricks or bituminous compound to prevent mechanical damage and moisture ingress. For additional protection, use bituminized paper and hessian tape on cable outer layers to prevent corrosion and electrochemical reactions.

Final Backfilling After securing the trays and cables, backfill the trench with soil, compacting it carefully to avoid tray deformation. Ensure manholes...
