Grounding and Earthing Connect all earth/ground bars to provide a safe path for fault currents. Proper grounding protects both equipment and personnel by safely dissipating excess current into the earth, reducing the risk of electric shock and short circuits.

Load Management Avoid overloading circuits by calculating the expected load and distributing it evenly across breakers. Overloaded circuits can degrade insulation and increase the risk of short circuits. Unplug unused appliances and avoid daisy-chaining multiple high-power devices.

Maintenance and Inspection Regularly inspect wiring, breakers, and insulation for signs of wear, heat damage, or corrosion. Replace damaged components immediately. Annual inspections by a qualified electrician ca...
