

How to quickly install a junction box

For metal boxes, attach the grounding wire to the green screw and connect all incoming/outgoing grounds with a pigtail. Push the connected wires neatly into the box, avoiding overfilling. Ensure the box size accommodates all conductors and splices.

Step 6: Close and Secure Attach the cover securely, ensuring it is accessible for future maintenance. For outdoor boxes, verify the gasket and sealing accessories are properly installed to prevent moisture ingress.
