

How to set up a fiber optic direct connection router

To set up a router with a direct fiber optic connection, you need an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) from your ISP, a compatible router with a Gigabit WAN port, and proper configuration of the router's settings.

Step 1: Gather Necessary Equipment

Step 3: Connect the Router

Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's Ethernet/LAN port to your router's WAN port. Power on the router and wait for the indicator lights to confirm a successful connection.

Step 4: Configure Router Settings

Access the router's admin panel via a web browser (commonly 192.168.1.1 or 192.168.0.1). Enter your ISP-provided credentials (PPPoE, DHCP, or VLAN settings as required). Update the router firmware to the latest version for security and performance. Set up Wi-Fi security and customize your network name (SSID). Optionally, enable Quality of Service (QoS) to prioritize traffic for video calls, gaming, or VoIP.

Step 5: Test and Optimize

Verify the connection by checking internet speed and device connectivity. Use wired connections for critical devices to maximize speed and reduce latency. Monitor performance and adjust settings if needed, including Wi-Fi channels and security protocols.

Additional Tips

- Position the ONT close to the fiber entry point to minimize signal loss.
