Cable Tray and Conduit Use: Approved wiring methods include armored cable, electrical metallic tubing, nonmetallic tubing, fire alarm cables, flexible metal conduit, and other listed cables suitable for cable trays or conduits. In hazardous locations, only permitted cable types may be used.
