

How to wire the jumper box in the distribution box

However, this method is explicitly prohibited by national standards because it can create dangerous overload conditions. The first wire from the main switch may carry the sum of currents from all downstream breakers, potentially exceeding the wire's rated capacity and causing overheating without tripping the breaker.

Safety Considerations

- Wire sizing:** Ensure wires are rated for the total current they will carry. For example, a 4 mm² copper wire typically handles up to 25A, while a 6 mm² wire handles up to 32A.
- Avoid prohibited jumper methods:** Household distribution boxes should not use jumpers that bypass individual breaker protection. Each breaker should receive a dedicated feed from the main switch.
- Heat dissipation:** Overcrowding...
