*The POE indicator only indicates the status of the network port and does not indicate the power supply status of the PoE. The power supply status of the PoE can be viewed through the device web

Understanding Switch LED Indicators

Green PoE mode is enabled, and the port LED displays green when the switch port is providing power. Amber PoE is disabled for the port. Blinking amber PoE mode is off due to a fault condition.

Switch LEDs

These port LEDs, as a group or individually, display information about the switch and about the individual ports. To select or change a mode, press the Mode button until the desired mode is
