

Installation of Flat Iron for Horizontal Cable Trays

Horizontal flat iron supports for cable trays must be installed with precise alignment, proper hanger spacing, and secure fastening to ensure safety, load capacity, and compliance with electrical codes. Preparation and Material Inspection Before installation, all cable trays, ladders, and fittings should be inspected for damage and verified against approved shop drawings to ensure compliance with project specifications. Materials should be stored horizontally on a flat surface with timber supports at intervals of approximately 1 meter to prevent deformation and protect against moisture and sunlight exposure. Layout and Marking Review the approved shop drawings to determine the exact routes, lengths, and locations of cable trays. Mark the horizontal and vertical runs on-site, ensuring proper coordination with other services and maintaining sufficient clearance for cable pulling and future maintenance. Hanger and Support Installation Use threaded rods and clamps to suspend the cable tray from the ceiling or structural support. Thread the upper hex nut onto the rod approximately 203 mm (8") above the tray bottom for single trays, or 50 mm (2") above the top rail for double ladder clamps. Place round washers between the hex nut and the clamp to distribute load evenly. Lift the tray so the threaded rod passes through the clamp holes, then secure with a second washer and hex nut. Adjust the nuts to achieve the desired tray height and ensure clamps are properly positioned. Maximum support spacing is typically 3.6 meters, with a load capacity per hanger ranging from 318 kg (700 lbs) to 340 kg (750 lbs) depending on the tray type. Alignment and Leveling Ensure the tray is level horizontally. Horizontal adjustment is limited by the length of the vertical rods; shorter rods allow less adjustment. For center-hung trays, position supports to allow easy cable installation...
