Cable Routing and Organization Lay cables neatly, separating high-power and low-power circuits to prevent EMI (). Use cable ties or straps, leaving slack for expansion or future adjustments (). For long runs, employ rollers or sheaves to avoid kinks and jacket damage ().

Grounding and Bonding Metallic trays must be properly grounded and bonded to meet NEC requirements, using bonding jumpers across sections to maintain electrical continuity ().

Documentation and Maintenance Label all cables and maintain an updated wiring map for troubleshooting and audits (). Conduct routine inspections to check for corrosion, loose clamps, or overfilled sections, ensuring long-term reliability ().
