

Installation of concealed sockets in distribution boxes



AI Overview

A concealed socket is installed by fixing the distribution box, routing conduits inside wall grooves, pulling wires, connecting to the socket, testing, and finally covering the conduits with plaster or cement.

Step 1: Distribution Box Placement Choose a dry, accessible location for the distribution box, typically at a height of around 1.5 meters for residential setups. Ensure proper ventilation and compliance with IP/NEMA ratings for protection against dust and moisture. The box should be securely mounted on a wall or embedded in a recess, with enough space for wiring and future maintenance.

Step 2: Wall Preparation and Box Fixing Mark the positions for the socket boxes and the distribution box on the wall. Cut wall grooves or recesses to accommodate the conduits. Fix the socket boxes and the distribution box in their designated positions, ensuring they are level and stable. For cast-in-situ installations, fill the boxes with polystyrene to prevent cement from entering during wall finishing.

Step 3: Conduit Installation Install PVC or metallic conduits inside the wall grooves, connecting the distribution box to the socket boxes. Ensure that the maximum straight run between two boxes does not exceed 25 meters, and limit bends to three quarter bends per run. Secure conduits properly to prevent movement during plastering.

Step 4: Wire Pulling Use fish tape or a similar tool to pull electrical wires through the conduits from the distribution box to the socket boxes. Select wires of appropriate gauge and type according to the load and local electrical codes. Ensure wires are not damaged or kinked during pulling.

Step 5: Socket Connection Connect the wires to the concealed socket terminals, following proper polarity and grounding practices. Ensure all connections are tight to prevent overheating or power failures. Connect the other end of the wires to the corresponding breakers or terminals inside the distribution box
