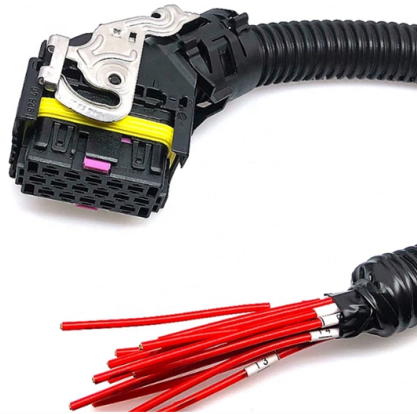

Placement and Mounting Install boxes on stable, elevated surfaces to prevent water ingress and mechanical damage. Avoid placing boxes directly on rough ground; use stands or mounting brackets. Ensure cables are routed safely to minimize tripping hazards and mechanical stress. 5. Safety Practices Only qualified personnel should handle installation and maintenance.
