

Instructions for installing the 7-pin cable tray fittings

Ensure supports can handle the maximum load per hanger (318–340 kg) and consider future cable additions (). Align the tray and fittings so that cables can be deposited smoothly without sharp bends, maintaining the minimum bend radius ().

Installing Fittings Connect 7-pin fittings according to the manufacturer's instructions, ensuring secure mechanical connections and proper alignment with the main tray. Use all-threaded hangers or approved fasteners for securing fittings to supports, avoiding drilling or cutting structural members unless approved (). Ensure grounding and bonding are properly implemented to maintain electrical safety ().

Cable Placement and Protection Lay cables carefully in the tray, avoiding damage from sharp edges or debris. Maintain spacing and separation for different cable types, especially for instr...
