

Is it okay to put the electrical distribution box on the staircase



Overview

While the National Electrical Code prohibits the placing of an electrical panel in tight spaces, it does not outlaw its installation under stairways – as long as the area is spacious enough. Panelboards contain circuit breakers that are overcurrent devices. You would still need the 6'-1/2' "headroom" required in 110. 26 (A) (3) would you not ?

Yup. To safely remove the dead front (cover plate of the panel) and work inside requires a stable surface to stand on and sufficient elbow room to move around. It's acceptable as long as the landing meets the code requirement for a safe access area in front of the panel: 2'-6" wide by 3'-0" deep level floor below it, and 6'-6" high clear above floor in front of it [NEC 110. In another thread that I can't find today, it was argued this isn't an NEC violation but does violate some building codes.
