

Is it safe to run fiber optic cables in cable trays

- Minimum Bend Radius:** Never bend the cable below its specified minimum bend radius, typically greater than 20 times the cable diameter, to prevent internal fiber breaks and signal loss .
- Pulling Tension:** Do not exceed the cable's maximum pulling tension. Use swivel grips and compatible lubricants to reduce friction and prevent damage .
- Twisting and Torsion:** Avoid twisting the cable during installation. Anti-twisting devices are recommended when pulling through trays or ducts .
- Cable Coiling:** When storing or deploying, coil the cable in a figure-8 or circular pattern to minimize mechanical stress .
- Routing and Separation**
- Avoid Physical Hazards:** Keep cables away from sharp edges, high temperatures, operating machinery, and uneven surfaces .
- Separation from Power Cables:** If the fiber cable contains metallic components, maintain adequate separation from power lines to prevent interference and safety risks .
- Intermediate Supports:** For vertical or long horizontal runs, clamp the cable at intervals to prevent sagging and ensure the weight does not exceed the recommended long-term load .
