Tracer wires run alongside the cable and can be detected with electromagnetic tools, while marker balls emit signals detectable by specialized locators. Proper installation of tracer wires, including leaving a portion above ground, ensures long-term traceability .
4. Ground-Penetrating Radar (GPR) GPR uses radar pulses to create images of subsurface objects, making it effective for detecting non-metallic fiber optic cables. It provides accurate detection with minimal environmental impact but requires skilled operators and specialized equipment .
5. Hydrovac Excavation For precise exposure of buried cables without damage, hydrovac excavation uses high-pressure water to remove soil. This method is particularly useful when exact cable location is critical f...
