Aerial Cable Placing Procedure

Aerial optical cable is suspended in the air from poles and/or support structures. Most often it is supported between poles by being lashed to a wire rope messenger strand with a small gauge wire.

ADSS optical cable construction and precautions

There must be enough excess cable on the pole tower at the splice box of each reel of optical cables, and the length of the excess cable of the splice is $\geq$ the height of the optical cable
